Grant-in-Aid Application  
for Funding in Project Year 2009***

The **2009 Aquatic Nuisance Control Program Grant-in-Aid Guide and Application** for municipalities to apply for funds to support aquatic nuisance control management activities in Vermont water bodies in 2009 is now available on line at:

For a project to be considered for funds in 2009 (State FY2010), a completed *Application Form* and *Worksheet*, according to the instructions provided, must be submitted. Submit an **original and one copy** of the entire package to: Danielle Dukette, VTDEC, Water Quality Division, 103 South Main Street, Building 10 North, Waterbury VT 05671-0408, **postmarked by Wednesday, March 4, 2009**. Electronic submittals will not be accepted.

The Grant-in-Aid Program may award a grant for up to 75% of the total estimated project cost. The Applicant must contribute at least 25% of the final eligible project cost through in-kind labor (unpaid personnel), in-kind services and/or actual cash expenditures (all from non-state sources). Grant recipients are required to provide certificates for **minimum coverage of insurance for worker's compensation, general liability and property damage, and automotive liability**. Insurance Guidelines are part of the application package (see Attachment B). We request that you provide the applicable certificates of insurance as part of your application submittal.
