AUTHORIZATION TO DISCHARGE UNDER THE
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM

In compliance with the provisions of the Clean Water Act (CWA), as amended (33 U.S.C. 1251 *et seq.*), and 10 VSA §§ 1250-1283, any operator who:

- submits a complete Notice of Intent (NOI) in accordance with Part 1.6.1,
- develops and implements a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) in accordance with the timetables in Part 2,
- for a discharge of stormwater associated with industrial activities,
- that is eligible for permit coverage under Part 1.3


is authorized to discharge stormwater to waters of the United States in accordance with the requirements set forth herein. Definitions of permit-specific terms used in this permit are provided in Appendix A. Standard permit conditions applicable to all authorized discharges are included in Appendix B.

This permit becomes effective on August 18, 2006

This permit and the authorization to discharge expire at midnight, August 18, 2011
