

NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF GENERAL PERMIT 3-9015
NEW STORMWATER DISCHARGES TO WATERS THAT ARE NOT PRINCIPALLY
IMPAIRED BY COLLECTED STORMWATER RUNOFF

Please be notified that the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources has issued general permit 3-9015 on this 24th day of March, 2003 for new discharges of stormwater runoff to waters of the State of Vermont that are not principally impaired by collected stormwater runoff.

This general permit will assure continued compliance with water quality standards in unimpaired waters and will assist in attainment of water quality standards in waters principally impaired by sources other than stormwater runoff. As required by 10 V.S.A. §1264(b), this general permit requires the implementation of stormwater management controls as specified in the 2002 Vermont Stormwater Management Manual.

Any person with an interest in this matter can appeal this decision pursuant to 10 V.S.A. Section 1269. Any notice of appeal must be filed (ie: received) at the Water Resources Board, National Life Records Center Building, Drawer 20, Montpelier, VT 05620-3201 (telephone (802) 828-3309) within 30 days of the date of the decision.
