

Orphaned Stormwater Systems Financial Assistance Application Checklist

A checklist is provided so you may ensure that your application is complete before it is sent to the Agency of Natural Resource for consideration. This list is for your records only and is not a formal part of the application.

Stormwater System:

- Total number of impervious acres (sidewalks, driveways, roofs, roads) covered by the expired permit (report as decimal, e.g. 1.4 ac). This must be determined from aerial photos or final site plans.
- A description of the stormwater system in place and its condition at time of application
- A description of any necessary repairs or construction necessary to ensure system is in compliance with the most recently issued permit.

Homeowners:

- List of all current homeowners
- Documentation of a Homeowner's Association (if the town will be a co-permittee)
- Resident status of all homeowners as per Vermont Department of Taxes
- The sum value of all the homes in the subdivision. Please use the same values that appear on the town's most recent Grand List.
- Number of individual properties in the subdivision.

Funding:

- Total amount of funds requested
- Please submit a description and itemized breakdown of any anticipated:
- Repair costs
 - Maintenance costs
 - Construction costs
 - Legal costs
 - Permit renewal fees (Do not include annual operating fees.)
 - A description of any individual, local, or in-kind contributions

Town:

- Copy of any and all easements or access agreements pertinent to the stormwater system

The town must certify in a written statement that it will

- Apply as either the sole or co-permittee
- Accept full responsibility for performing necessary repair, maintenance, upgrading and construction pertinent to the Stormwater System
- Submit a complete General Permit 3-9010 Application no later than two years of the grant award
